Keep your dog under close control, especially around livestock, horses, deer and wildlife.



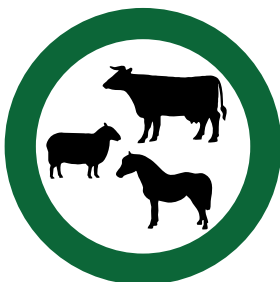
Enjoy a picnic but please NO BBQ's or campfires. Remember to take your litter home.



Respect the wildlife. Leave behind what you find for others to enjoy.



Protect the habitat by sticking to the paths. This prevents disturbing nesting birds too.



Respect the livestock, look from afar. Do not approach the animals.



Respect other Forest visitors. Give people and horseriders space to pass, keep noise to a minimum.
